

Leadership Commission Report – 9.25.2021

“That NCCW will encourage the utilization of a mentoring program at all levels of the organization which encourages the mentee to act outside her comfort zone while trying new tasks; and that NCCW will encourage all levels of council to utilize the mentoring program by publishing articles about mentoring in *Catholic Woman* magazine and *Connect*.”

These were resolutions from the 2017 NCCW Annual Convention and the theme for this Leadership Commission will be mentoring and how to get more active and involved members.

Going to the NCCW website under Leadership Commission you will find an eight-page document entitled “Women Embracing Women” which introduces the mentoring program and gives a step-by-step plan to introduce mentoring into all levels of the council, as well as into any organization that would like to encourage more active and involved members.

To help with mentoring or other programs that will benefit our councils, LTD (Leadership, Training, and Development) has introduced Council Enrichment Programs via Zoom.
