Spring Deanery Meeting

The Convention in 2020 will be held in our Deanery. This marks the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the NCCW. Aimee Place informed us that the chairs for this convention will be Susan Collins and Kathy DeAngelis. Kathy reported that they have looked at the Best Western Convention Center off of exit 8 on I81. They are renovating the rooms now and should be done by this summer. The dates are April 23-25<sup>th</sup> 2020. They are thinking one Mass at Holy Trinity and on Mass at St. Patrick's. The main meetings to be held at the hotel.

Ginger Curran made a motion for the chairs to book the hotel for April 23-25. Anne Wharton seconded it. Motion carried.

The National Council of Catholic Women Convention will be held in Atlanta on August 21-24. Early bird registration is \$300 from March 1-June 1. The registration fee will go up to \$350 after June 1 until cut off on July 29. The room rates are \$ 139 single, \$159 double, \$179 triple and \$199 quad.

The meeting was adjourned for Mass.

Pat Ryan will be our new Province Director. She will be installed at the NCCW Convention in Atlanta.
